### FY2016 AND FY2017 APPROPRIATED FUNDS BUDGET UPDATE

**Summary:** This item includes an update regarding funds appropriated for FY2016 and FY2017,

payments made thus far under an appropriations bill approved June 30, 2016, and

programs not funded or underfunded for FY2016.

With no funding yet allocated for scholarships and grants for the 2016-17 academic year and the General Assembly not scheduled to return until November 15th, another academic year is beginning with great uncertainty for students, families, and the

Illinois colleges and universities that serve them.

Included in the item is a table that details appropriations for FY2015-FY2017, along with the Commission's FY2017 recommendation and the Governor's FY2017

request.

#### ILLINOIS STUDENT ASSISTANCE COMMISSION

#### FY2016 AND FY2017 APPROPRIATED FUNDS BUDGET UPDATE

As of this writing, the State is entering the third month of FY2017. The General Assembly and Governor approved an appropriations bill on June 30, 2016, that included appropriations for both FY2016 and FY2017, but a comprehensive budget for FY2016 was never enacted. Although the measure (now Public Act 99-254) has been referred to by some as "a half-year budget," this is true only in the sense that it authorizes spending for state general funds for costs incurred through December 31, 2016. The state programs and services that the Act funds are not necessarily supported at the levels required to conduct six months of activity—particularly since many entities spent the previous year providing services without receiving any payment, and therefore the available funding is being used to cover old costs.

There is little reason to expect further FY2016 appropriations, although the FY2016 spending that has been approved for ISAC-administered programs falls short of prior year levels and is likely to create challenges for students and institutions.

As of today, timely MAP claims for 2015-16 have been paid, and staff are currently processing tuition and fee payments that will make Golden Apple Scholars whole for costs incurred during Spring 2016. The Golden Apple Foundation, which runs the Golden Apple Scholars of Illinois Program, will soon receive the other component of the program's funding, a pass-through grant that supports aspects of the program such as stipends for mentoring, summer teaching, etc.. Payments are also being processed for Fall 2015 claims from the Grant Program for the Dependents of Police, Fire, and Correctional Officers killed or permanently disabled in the line of duty.

Still unfunded for FY2016 are the claims from the remainder of the 2015-16 academic year for students eligible for the Dependents' Grant, along with the Minority Teachers of Illinois (MTI) grant program and all state loan repayment assistance programs. Support for the Golden Apple Foundation is also significantly reduced from the levels that the state provided in recent years.

The programmatic budget for FY2017 is even less certain: No funding has been allocated for scholarships and grants for the 2016-17 academic year. With the General Assembly not scheduled to return until November 15<sup>th</sup> (and some officials commenting that they do not expect final action on a budget until January at the earliest), another academic year is beginning with great uncertainty for students, families, and the Illinois colleges and universities that serve them.

The June funding bill does authorize a full year of spending from federal funds and special state funds (accounts outside the state's general funds) for FY2017. This includes ISAC's Student Loan Operating Fund and authorization to spend the proceeds of any federal or private contracts or grants that the agency secures. However, the Act does <u>not</u> include state general funds support for agency operations or statewide outreach, research, and training for FY2017, although these were recommended by the Governor in his FY2017 requested in February.
