

Determining 2007-08 Illinois Monetary Award Program (MAP) Award Amounts

Illinois Monetary Award Program maximum eligibility is calculated based on a student budget, which is 2003-04 tuition and fees (no cap) plus a uniform living allowance of \$4,875 (for academic year 2007-08), minus an Illinois inflated EFC including a minimum student self-help expectation of \$1,800, minus 80 percent of Pell eligibility.

For academic year 2007-2008, MAP initial awards are limited to the lessor of the program maximum award of \$4,968, 100 percent of academic year 2003-2004 tuition and fees, or maximum eligibility. A student must have a minimum initial eligibility of \$300 to be considered for an award. Initial awards for less than the program maximum award or tuition and fees are rounded in \$150 increments. No awards are provided to applicants with a federal EFC of \$9,000 or greater.

For academic year 2007-2008, no award reduction factor is applied to initial awards.
