Fall 2023 – Summer 2024 Illinois National Guard (ING) Grant Program Notice of Eligibility

The Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) has determined that you are eligible to receive benefits for the 2023-24 Illinois National Guard (ING) Grant Program. As a reminder, you must file an application annually indicating your college choice. Benefits will not be administered until a current application is on file.

Effective with the 2023-24 academic year, there will no longer be priority consideration dates by which ING Grant applications must be submitted each term. Rather, ING Grant applications must be received by ISAC in time for eligibility to be determined and the applicant to then notify the college about their eligibility no later than the last scheduled day of classes for the first term for which benefits have been requested.

The information below details your current eligibility status based on whether you have reached the maximum units allowed under the ING Grant Program, your application and/or information provided by the Department of Military Affairs Illinois (DMAIL), Education and Incentives Office and the college(s) you indicated you plan to attend. Any updates to your Guard status must be submitted to ISAC by DMAIL.

- ISAC will verify your status with DMAIL. If DMAIL or your college determines you are not eligible, you will receive a NOTICE of Ineligibility. Your college will verify your enrollment and eligibility for the program. Your college may require a copy of this letter. It is your responsibility to ensure that the financial aid office has received notification of your eligibility. Failure to present the eligibility letter to your college and/or to notify ISAC of a college choice change, as required, may result in the loss of benefits.
