Rather, ING Grant applications must be received by ISAC in time for eligibility to be determined and the applicant to then notify the college about their eligibility no later than the last scheduled day of classes for the first term for which benefits have been requested.

Your eligibility is restricted or limited to a portion of the academic year due to your Guard status. Your college will prorate your eligibility and you are responsible for the remaining costs.
