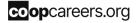
Program Eligibility

Participants must meet ALL the criteria below:

- Graduated or will graduate with a Bachelor's degree between 8/15/14-8/15/24.
 - Unemployed and do not have significant fulltime, professional work experience, OR
- Underemployed (meaning you make \$50k and/or your current job doesn't require a degree).
- A U.S. citizen or legally authorized to work in the U.S. without restriction.
- At least 21 years of age by 8/15/24.
- 5 Live in or near a city that we serve
- 6 Available four evenings (M-TH) per week.

Participants identify with AT LEAST one of the criteria:

- First Generation College Grad: You (or a sibling) are the first in your immediate family to earn a Bachelor's in the United States.
- Financial Aid Recipient: You qualified for Pell grants or state financial aid during most, or all, of your time in college.

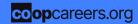

- Information sessions which help your students join COOP faster



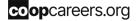
Invite

Prepared

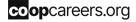
All participants graduate with a strong foundation in Excel, skills certifications, and hands-on project experience in digital marketing, data analytics, or financial services.

Seventy-nine percent of participants are first-generation college graduates and 100% invest an extra 200 hours in their personal and professional development following graduation.

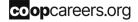
