Who We Are and Who We Serve

- Small, Private Health Professions and Nursing College
 - Peoria, IL
 - Offer typical student services
- 2022-2023
 - 550 Students
 - 220 Students were self-reported First-Generation Students
 - Primarily serving Non-Traditional students
- NCLEX Pass rates 2023 up 13% to 96%
 - Total First-time, U.S.-educated 88.56%

Why Student Led

- Helps students to determine:
 - What is realistic
 - How to resolve conflict
 - What options are available
 - Appropriateness of programming
 - Ultimately creates student buy-in and participation
