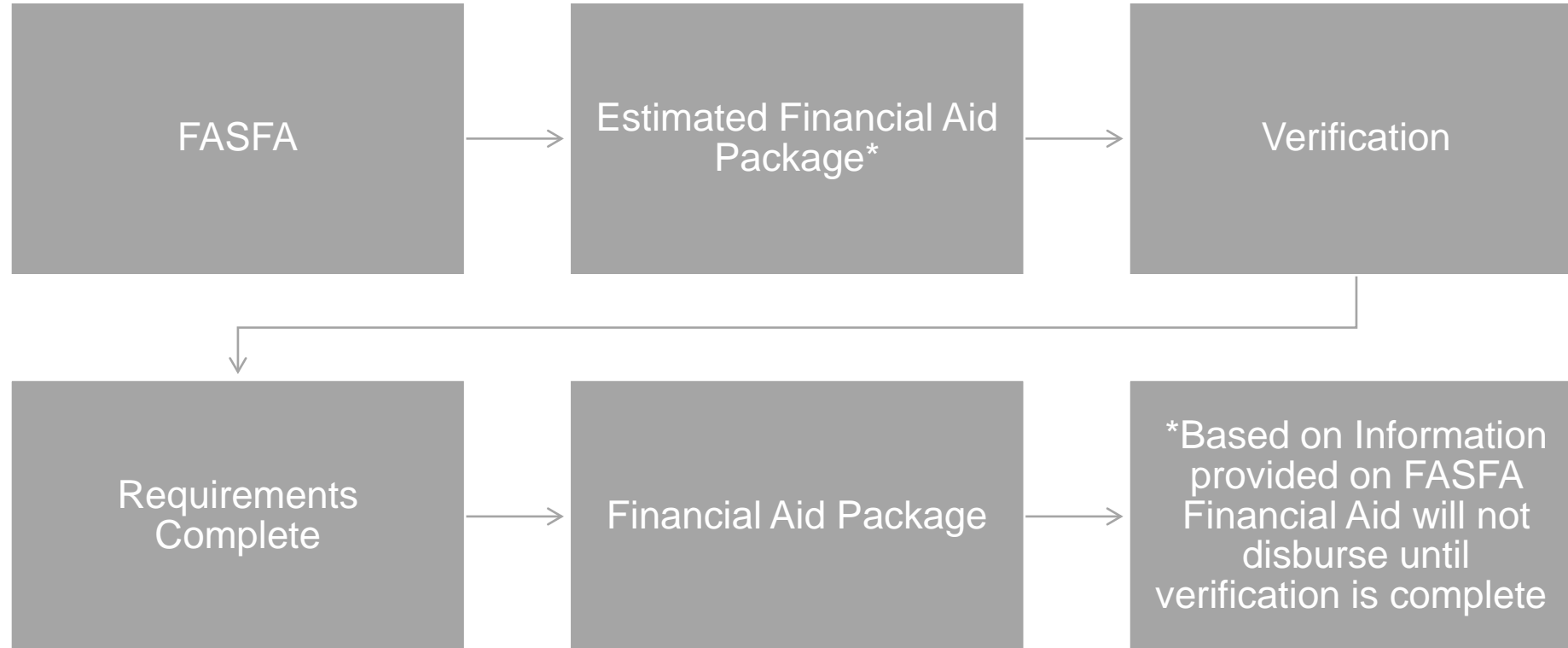


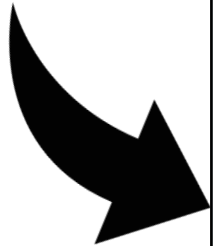

Who Should Complete This?

Any student, regardless of income, who wants to be considered for federal, state, and school financial aid programs, which includes scholarships, grants, loans, and Federal work-study.

How Long Will it Take?

It takes most people less than an hour to complete, including gathering any documents or data needed.


- FSA-ID is now required before starting the FAFSA
- Can now create FSA-ID if you do not have a social security number
- Will require a multi-factor authentication login (I.E.DUO)

Student Provides Consent

All persons on the FAFSA must provide **consent** for the Department of Education to receive tax information or confirmation of non-filing status directly from the IRS.

Provide Consent or Be Ineligible for Federal Student Aid

Summary

Your consent is needed to retrieve and disclose federal tax information (FTI). With your consent, we can obtain tax return information automatically from the IRS to help you complete the FAFSA[®] form. If you don't provide consent, you will not be eligible for federal student aid, including grants and loans. You must provide consent even if you didn't file a U.S. federal tax return or any tax return at all.


- Get your 2022 tax return information for the 2024-25 FAFSA form.
- Tax return information is required to complete the FAFSA form.
- FTI is used to determine your eligibility for federal student aid.

Under penalty of law, I certify that I am the individual associated with the FSA ID log-in credentials used to access the FAFSA form to provide the necessary approval and consent for the disclosure and use of my federal tax information (FTI) from the U.S. Department of the Treasury. 


*If you have a stepparent who is **married to the legal parent** whose information you're reporting, you must provide information about that stepparent as well.

Student Invites Parents to FAFSA® Form

- If parent(s) you are reporting are married, ask them if they file taxes jointly or separately.
- Enter personal information about your parent(s) to invite them to your FAFSA® form.
- If parent(s) are married and file taxes separately, both must complete FAFSA after being invited. If filed jointly only one parent must complete.
- Parent(s) must have FSA-ID to sign in and complete.



Verification

- The Federal Government randomly selects FAFSAs each year for verification
- Must provide documentation to verify information on FAFSA
 - Dependent/Independent Verification Form
 - Signed Copy of Federal Tax Return

There are also scholarship searches that will charge you a fee. Since there are plenty of online services that don't charge, we suggest that you use the free ones. Stay alert to possible scams. If the guarantee or offer sounds too good to be true, you should probably avoid it.
