

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA[®]) Communication Toolkit

For the 2024-25 FAFSA[®] and Alternative Application for Illinois Financial Aid

Introduction

This guide is designed to assist practitioners who support students and families through the financial aid process. The guide provides resources to help streamline communication to ensure students and families receive the information and assistance they need to navigate this process.

This is an especially crucial year as the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA[®]) and Alternative Application for Illinois Financial Aid (Alternative App) became available in December 2023 rather than their usual opening date of October 1st, as a result of changes to the FAFSA[®] stemming from the FAFSA Simplification Act.

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Last updated: January 19, 2024

To get started, identify your goals, audiences, and timeline. Use these questions will help create concise messaging.

- What is your goal? Choose key points to highlight.
 - Inform students of the FAFSA[®]/Alternative App opening date
 - o Inform parents of an upcoming financial aid workshop
 - Inform parents of the information they need for the financial aid workshop
 - Recruit volunteers, etc.
- Who needs this information?
 - Your audience will vary depending on your goal
 - o If different messages are required, identify all audience groups
 - Determine how messages will differ by audience (or platform, e.g., social media)
- When does each audience group need the information?
 - o Establish a communication timeline
 - Different audiences will need the information at different times
 - E.g., if you are recruiting volunteers to assist at a financial aid workshop, you will likely need to communicate with them first to ensure you have volunteers prior to inviting students and parents
- How are you sharing the information?
 - o Phone
 - o In-person
 - o Flyer
 - o Social media, etc.

Set Your Plan in Motion

Once you have a plan, work on the execution.

- Identify materials and resources needed
 - o Printer
 - Social media access
 - o Phone numbers
 - o Emails, etc.
- Recruit volunteers depending on your method(s) of communication, you may need to enlist the help of volunteers
 - o Callers for phone bank
 - Distributing flyers at report card night or parent/teacher meetings
 - o Assisting at financial aid workshop
- Execute spread the word!
 - Send out your initial message
 - o Periodically remind your audience
 - o Try different methods of communication

- Plan early
- Identify key audiences
 - o Students
 - o Parents
 - Volunteers, etc.
- Plan your message and communication method for each audience group
- Utilize different communication methods to best fit the needs of your students and families
 - o Robocalls
 - o Mass emails
 - o Flyers, etc.
- Send periodic reminders prior to FAFSA opening date
- Send periodic reminders prior to any financial aid application completion workshops
