What is One Click College Admit?

One Click College Admit is a program that lets you receive college acceptance offers automatically based on your GPA without applications, essays, or application fees.

Why should I care?

This program helps you:

- Get accepted to college earlier
- Save time and stress
- Keep more options open for senior year
- Avoid unnecessary application fees and extra work

How does it work?

1. Opt-in to the program (parent/guardian permission required if you're under 18)
2. Create a Common App account
3. Colleges review your GPA
4. Acceptance offers appear in your Common App and email

Am I committing to a college if I opt-in?

No. It just gives you options.

Opting in:

- Does not lock you into a college
- Does not stop you from applying elsewhere
- Does not require you to decide right away

What happens senior year?

If you qualify, you'll:

- See college acceptance offers in Common App in the Fall
- You can accept more than one offer while you're deciding
- Compare schools, programs, and financial aid
- Enroll at the college that's best for you

How much does it cost?

Nothing. It's 100% free.

Who can help me?

Your school counselor and ISAC representatives are here to help you every step of the way.

What will I need?

You will need a device with internet access, and a parent or guardian to provide consent.

Does this replace the FAFSA?

No. You will still need to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine your eligibility for federal and state financial aid. Completing the FAFSA is a graduation requirement.

Will I need to fill out applications for specific programs within a college?

That depends on the college and the program. Students who participate in One Click College Admit can expect to receive general offers of admission from participating colleges. However, some universities require applications for certain selective programs or majors. In those instances, One Click College Admit just makes part of the process easier.

An Overview of OCCA Steps:

1. Complete the OCCA Opt-In Form with your parent/guardian during junior year
2. Create a Common App account before senior year
3. ISAC matches your GPA with participating colleges over the summer
4. Review college admission offers in fall of senior year
5. To add colleges, you will navigate to “My Colleges” in Common App
6. Complete enrollment, fill out the FAFSA, and complete any additional steps for financial aid
