

## Marengo Community High School PaCE: Postsecondary and Career Expectations

Each student should have an individualized learning plan to help make decisions on careers and postsecondary (PS) education or training, plan a course of study, and make financial aid assessments with family members.

A student should be supported to:  → Complete a career cluster survey and take a career interest survey  → Create a resume  → Meet with counselor to discuss coursework and PS/career plans  → Begin determining eligibility for AP courses  A student should know:  → 1 or 2 career clusters for further exploration and development  → The relationship between high school coursework, attendance and grade to PS plans  Career Exploration and Development  Career Exploration and Development  Post-Secondary Education Exploration, Preparation, Preparation, and Selection	A student should be supported to:  → Complete an orientation course to a career cluster  → Select a career pathway (CP) within a career cluster of interest  → Begin determining eligibility for AP courses  → Identify 2-3 adults to support him/her through the PS and career selection process  → Review coursework and PS/career plans with counselor  A student should know:  → The "8 Essential Workplace Skills"  → Educational requirements, costs, expected entry level and midpoint salary for a selected career  → Compare education and average salary connection  → General timing of PS entrance exams	A student should be supported to:  → Identify a job shadow opportunity relation to CP  → Complete or enroll in at least one early college credit opportunity  → Attend a college fair  → Visiting at least 3 PS institutions and/or training centers  → Take at least 1 college entrance exam  A student should know:  → Financial aid resources to pursue PS training  → 3-5 match schools and 1 safety school for PS program	By 12/31 of 12th grade a student should have:  → Completed the FAFSA → Applied to 3-5 PS options → Met with counselor to ensure all steps in the PS and admission process are completed on time  A student should be supported to: → Visit at least 1 workplace aligned to career interests → Update resume → If applicable, obtain an internship opportunity related to CP → If applicable, receive industry based certification related to CP → Complete 1 or more team based challenges or projects related to CP → Attend a financial aid workshop  A student should know: → Terms/conditions of any scholarships & loans → Estimated cost of each PS option
