

Updates

- FSA-ID is now required before starting the FAFSA
- Can now create FSA-ID if you do not have a social security number
- Will require a multi-factor authentication login (I.E.DUO)

Who needs an FSA-ID?

- > Student
- Spouse(if married)
- > Parents

Student Provides Consent




All persons on the FAFSA must provide **consent** for the Department of Education to receive tax information or confirmation of non-filing status directly from the IRS.



Student Personal Circumstances Section



The student is asked a series of questions to determine their dependency status.



Who's My Parent Wizard?



Answer questions about **BOTH** parents if:

- Your parents are living and legally married to each other.
- Your parents are living together and are not married.
- Your parents are divorced or separated but living together.

Answer questions about **ONE** parent if:

- Your parent is widowed or was never married.
- Your parents are divorced or separated and not living together. Answer the
 questions about the parent who provided more financial support over the past 12
 months or if they do not support you, answer the questions about the parent with
 the greater income or assets in the questions that follow. *


*If you have a stepparent who is **married to the legal parent** whose information you're reporting, you must provide information about that stepparent as well.

Student Invites Parents to FAFSA® Form



- > If parent(s) you are reporting are married, ask them if they file taxes jointly or separately.
- Enter personal information about your parent(s) to invite them to your FAFSA® form.
- > If parent(s) are married and file taxes separately, both must complete FAFSA after being invited. If filed jointly only one parent must complete.
- Parent(s) must have FSA-ID to sign in and complete.





Verification





- The Federal Government randomly selects FAFSAs each year for verification
- Must provide documentation to verify information on FAFSA
 - Dependent/Independent Verification Form
 - Signed Copy of Federal Tax Return



Offer Letter




- A notification will be sent to the student's email listed on the Admission Application unless the student has registered for class

- The email will have instructions on how to log into SalukiNet to view and accept your financial aid offer



Aim High/Saluki Commitment



Our pledge that all New and Transfer students who meet certain criteria are guaranteed that tuition and mandatory fees be fully covered.

Criteria:

- •Be a first-time incoming freshman or transfer enrolling full-time in the fall 2021 semester or later.
- •Have a cumulative high school GPA of 2.75 or higher, 2.0 transfer gpa.
- •Have an annual family income less than \$103,040 with assets less than \$50,000 based on your FAFSA.
- •Be an Illinois resident who attended an Illinois high school.
- •Be a dependent student under age 24.
- •Be eligible for Federal financial aid.

Aim High/Saluki Commitment



WHAT'S COVERED

- ✓ Tuition and mandatory fees after all financial aid is applied.
- ✓ Coverage is guaranteed for eight (four if transfer) consecutive semesters
- ✓ Total aid will not exceed the cost of tuition and mandatory fees, Saluki Commitment is to be the last dollar after MAP and PELL.

Academic Merit Scholarships



New freshmen applicants are automatically reviewed for merit-based scholarships based on qualifying credentials at the time of admission. Students will be notified of their scholarship offer by email.

- -Saluki Maroon Scholarship: 2.75-2.99 GPA
 - \$1,500 per year/Total value \$6,000
- -Saluki Silver Scholarship: 3.0-3.49 GPA
 - \$2,500 per year/Total value \$10,000
- -Saluki Gold Scholarship: 3.5-3.79 GPA
 - \$3,500 per year/Total value \$14,000
- -University Excellence Scholarship: 3.8
 - \$5,500 per year/Total value \$22,000




